
EAT



GOLF

Whether skilled or novice, there's a course for you. In fact, there are 13 courses within a 20-minute radius and each comes with stunning vistas, challenging shots, and emerald fairways. With mild temperatures throughout the year, golf in Greater Zion is a year-round activity.



HIKING

The combination of red rock plateaus, candy-colored cliffs, and green pine forests make Greater Zion's terrain some of the most incredible and diverse, especially for hiking. Get out to see lava tubes, slot canyons, petrified dunes, and petroglyphs. With four state parks and over 300 miles of trails to explore, Greater Zion is a hikers paradise.



ATV/OHV

Greater Zion's diverse landscape lends to the ultimate ATV/OHV experience and extends the promise of breathtaking vistas, many of which can only be accessed in an off-road vehicle. Sand Mountain at Sand Hollow State Park delivers miles of warm sand dunes and red slick-rock climbs while Pine Valley Mountain offers tall green pine trees and mountain air.



TEAM BUILDING

Here, trust falls come with a harness. Venture through ferratas such as the 'The Eye of The Needle' and 'Angels Leading Ledgewalk' or strengthen your team by participating in an activity such as canyoneering or rock climbing.





UNDERNEATH BLUE SKIES

300+ days of sunshine means 300+ days of pure inspiration in Greater Zion and some of the best scenery and recreation in the country can be found here. Perfect weather and clear skies are ideal for exploring one of our four state parks located within a 20-minute radius of St. George, each of which provides its own brand of scenery and outdoor adventure. 

ARTS IN GREATER ZION

TUACAHN OUTDOOR AMPHITHEATRE

Tuacahn Outdoor Amphitheatre is set amid a stunning red rock backdrop deep in Padre Canyon with a 90-foot stage with a 2,000 seat amphitheater. Tuacahn (pronounced Too'-a'kahn) is the home of Broadway-style shows featuring musicals with elaborate sets and costumes, seasonal concerts, and other special events. These shows that run from May to October are a treat on a warm summer evening in the canyon, and this spectacular setting makes for an experience outdone by none. If you haven't seen it at Tuacahn, you just haven't seen it!

Outside their typical season, Tuacahn hosts a variety of events including 'Thriller', bull riding, a concert series, the nativity, a holiday show in their 2,000-seat indoor theatre, and various other events.


ADDITIONAL ARTS VENUES




